

Chervin Kitchen & Bath Inc. Limited Warranty

All Chervin custom kitchen products are guaranteed to be free from defects in material and workmanship for five years from the date of installation by a factory authorized installer. All hardware carries a lifetime guarantee by the hardware manufacturer. If, after inspection by a factory representative, a product is found to be defective, it will be repaired or replaced at the discretion of Chervin Kitchen & Bath Inc.

There are several exceptions:

This warranty does NOT cover damage caused by abuse or misuse or by normal wear and tear. The warranty does not cover kitchens that are used in a commercial situation.

In normal home construction buildings settle over time causing cracks in walls and occasionally in countertop seams. This warranty does not provide for repair to damage caused by such settling.

Improper ventilation or excessive moisture, spills and humidity can cause damage to cabinets and doors. This warranty does not provide for these events.

Wood is a product of nature. Normal aging and exposure to sunlight, smoke or household solvents can cause variations in the colour of wood and are not to be considered a defect.

Normal expansion and contraction in wood can cause hairline cracks at the joints in doors which do not weaken the finish nor the door whatsoever and are not to be considered defects.

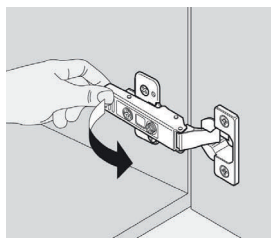
Subsequently, any replacement parts provided will closely match the original colour but cannot be guaranteed to be an identical colour match.

This represents all of the Chervin Kitchen & Bath Inc. warranty. No third party is authorized to amend or alter this warranty.

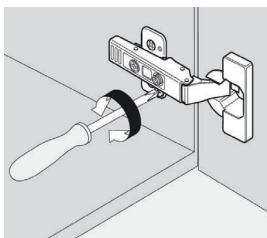
Care and Maintenance Tips

- Clean up spills immediately.
- Use only water and mild soap when cleaning your cabinets. Abrasive soaps and cleaners that contain harsh chemicals and/or bleach can damage or discolor cabinets and should not be used.
- Prolonged exposure to moisture or excessive water can cause damage and void your warranty.
- When cleaning glass components, try to keep glass cleaners off wood parts.
- Never place a hot cooking utensil directly on countertops.
- To remove or adjust cabinet doors follow the diagrams below.

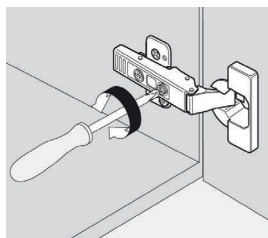
Removal



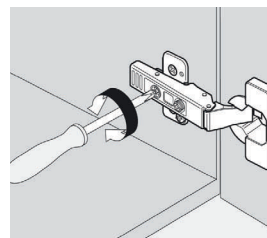
Adjust Height

Natural Stone Countertops

- Use only water and mild soap to clean your countertop. Do not use cleaners that include lemon, vinegar, or other acids. Do not use abrasives or harsh chemicals.
- Protect your countertop from foods containing acids such as citrus juices or alcohol by using coasters under glasses.
- Natural stone countertops should be treated with sealer at least once a year. Natural stone sealer can be purchased at most hardware stores.
