





# VANITY Styles

## TRADITIONAL

Permanently affixed to the wall and floor; featuring a toe kick or base moulding; may be paired with "piers" for additional storage above the main vanity.

## FURNITURE STYLE

Typically featuring four legs as the base; stylistically designed with the look of a cabinet, sturdy set of shelves, or chest.

## FLOATING

Affixed to the wall in such a way that no base or legs are needed - substantial space is left between the bottom of the vanity and the floor for an airy, modern look.

## SINGLE BASIN

Traditional, furniture-style, or floating vanity designed to hold a single sink (typically centred); great choice for powder rooms and ensuites.

## DOUBLE BASIN

Traditional, furniture-style, or floating vanity designed to hold two sinks to facilitate multi-person bathroom use for households.
